

## Rules of Match Play:

1. First person/team to win 8 games (8 game pro set) wins the match. If the time expires in a session the player/team that is ahead in games/tiebreaker points wins the match.
2. If the set score is tied 7-7 games players will proceed to a 12 point tiebreaker. First person/team to win 7 points wins the match. Players need to win by two points in the tiebreaker to win.
3. A 10 minute warning will be announced near the end of each session.
  - a. If you are in the middle of a game at the announcement of the 10 minute warning, finish that game then:
    - i. If one team is up two games (4-2, 5-3, 7-5), that team wins
    - ii. If the teams are tied – go immediately to 12 point tie breaker.
    - iii. If one team is ahead by 1 game, play one additional game then
      1. If the score is tied go immediately to 12 point tie breaker
      2. If one team is up two games, that team wins.
  - b. If you are between games (next game has not started) at 10 minute warning then:
    - i. If one team is up two games, that team wins
    - ii. If the teams are tied – go immediately to 12 point tie breaker.
    - iii. If one team is ahead by 1 game, play one additional game then
      1. If the score is tied go immediately to 12 point tie breaker
      2. If one team is up two games, that team wins.
4. Starting this week we will be playing no-add scoring. First player to win 4 points win the game.
5. If the score is tied 3-3 points (40—40) than the player/team that is receiving serve has the choice of what side they would like to receive the ball (Ad or Deuce/left or right side of the court).
  - a. The one exception to this rule is men cannot receive a woman's serve in mix doubles.
6. Each match is worth one point
7. Winners of each match are responsible for reporting your score to one of the core members following the match. Failing to do so will be an automatic forfeit of the match to your opponent.

## **Rules for Roster:**

All 12 matches will be pre-selected and submitted 10 minutes before play is to begin.

Please arrive 15 minutes prior to match start. 1:00pm for first session, 3:30pm for second session.

Matches will start promptly with a 5 minute warm up ONLY:

*Session 1* 1:15 pm

*Session 2* 2:00 pm

*Session 3* 2:45 pm

*Session 4* 3:45 pm

*Session 5* 4:30 pm

*Session 6* 5:15 pm

Each doubles team **MUST** consist of a mix of different team members. *For example: Michael Chang and Carl Chang cannot play men's doubles together for more than one match per team match.*

Players must be on the court by the scheduled time.

Teams who have insufficient players will be defaulted for that match.

USTA Code of Conduct will be enforced at all times by the Core Team.
